ORDINANCE NO. 482

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF CERTAIN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY
WITHIN THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Morrison is a Colorado home rule municipality operating under a Charter approved by the electorate pursuant to Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and governed by its elected Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has authority pursuant to the Home Rule Charter and C.R.S. §31-16-101, et seq. to adopt and enforce all ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has authority under CRS 43-2-203 to consider the vacation of certain public rights-of-way within the Town; and

WHEREAS, having considered the application of James Jones for vacation of portions of certain public rights-of-way, the Board of Trustees hereby finds and determines as follows:

1. the identified portions of public rights-of-way are no longer needed by the Town to serve any public purpose; and
2. vacation of the identified portions of public rights-of-way will not leave any adjacent property owner without access to the public roadway system; and
3. vacation of the identified portions of public rights-of-way is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Morrison, Colorado, that:


Section 1. Public rights-of-way vacated. The portions of 10 feet of the easterly right of way of Union Avenue and 10 feet of the southerly right of way of Bear Creek Avenue, which are public rights-of-way identified on **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby vacated pursuant to law.

Section 2. Recording. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder and to take such other ministerial and clerical actions necessary to implement the decision of the Board of Trustees via this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect 15 days after adoption and publication in accordance with Section 3.9(a)(8) of the Morrison Home Rule Charter as amended by vote of the Morrison electorate on April 3, 2018.
