

## Greetings from the Morrison Police Department

Early summer has proven busy with criminal activity in and around Morrison. However, Morrison Officers with the assistance of Jefferson County Deputies have intercepted, arrested and filed on these individuals in both cases.

In the first incident, a Wheat Ridge resident and victim of a stolen car happened to be driving on eastbound C-470 the next day when he observed his own car in front of him.

Calling the police, Morrison Officers staged to intercept.

After following the vehicle on the highway to Quincy Avenue, where it crashed into a sign post, the suspects were caught after fleeing the stolen car. Like CSI TV itself, DNA and fingerprints were used to bring charges against the suspects, clearing the case by arrest.



The second incident involved a late night burglary of one of our local businesses along main street. Here thieves decided to “break and enter” helping themselves to a bottle of tequila. However, in the process they caused substantially more damage to the business than the price of the liquor itself. Aided by a real time camera system, the owner was able to watch the crime in progress alerting the police. Converging on the area with assistance from Jefferson County, the thieves were quickly arrested fleeing the area. With the help of the enhanced video surveillance to identify the suspects, charges are currently pending those arrested in this case.

## UTILITY DEPARTMENT

### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT:

As some of you may have noticed, the operating reservoir is low. The Utility Department is draining the Town of Morrison's operating reservoir for routine maintenance. The Utility Department must inspect the suction/discharge line to the reservoir. Over the years, more and more silt has been collecting at the bottom of the reservoir. This has caused an abundance of silt, sand and debris in the raw water line. We are addressing the issue by clearing around the area of the suction/discharge pipe and evaluating what further work needs to be done in the future. The reservoir will be at a lower elevation, and we encourage residents to stay out of the reservoir and remain on the banks behind the caution tape, as there are a lot of loose rocks and steep hills that create an unsafe environment.




